| Comprehensive, institution-wide license allows librarians, researchers, faculty, administrators, and staff to use and share text-based copyrighted content, reducing need for pay-per-use permissions | ✓ |

External promotional and advertising use

Interlibrary Loan (ILL)/document delivery — ILL borrowing and distribution, as well as document delivery by the institution's library/libraries, are not covered under the license.

The reproduction of the entire work is prohibited unless specifically noted by the rightsholder
